Free Income Tax Assistance - Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) will be at The Bible Chapel, 300 Gallery Dr., McMurray, PA beginning Monday, February 2 through Wednesday, April 15, 2015. (Closed Good Friday, April 3rd.) Hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. No appointments, only walk-ins. Gallery Drive is located 5 miles south of the South Hills Village on the west side of Route 19, adjacent to South Hills Chrysler-Jeep. Follow signs 0.4 mile to the VITA entrance. Volunteers will assist taxpavers with Federal, PA, and local wage tax returns, real estate/rent rebates, and PACE applications. Please bring: Copy of last year's tax return. W-2's and 1099's and all other income and interest statements. Total of itemized deductions. Receipts for real estate taxes and large purchase items. Total paid to day care provider and their tax ID number. A voided check for direct deposit of refund. Proof of ID for yourself and spouse. Birth dates and Social Security or Individual Taxpayer identification cards or notices for you, your spouse and dependents. If married filing jointly both spouses should be present.
